Credit by Exam for Acceleration without Prior Instruction

Aledo ISD will provide Credit by Examination (CBE) without prior instruction in grades one through twelve for the purpose of course acceleration provided the following criteria have been met:

- Students must be enrolled in Aledo ISD to be eligible for CBE's
- Completed registration form submitted to campus Principal or CBE designee by the scheduled registration deadline – late registration is not available
- Student may not have attempted CBE more than twice in the same subject
- Student must have passed and received scores from previous course to schedule the next course (IE: pass Math 7A/7B before registering to take Math 8A/8B)
- Based on District policy, only exams administered by the District will be considered for credit

*If the vendor develops a TEA approved form of these tests during the year we will update our offerings.

Testing will be offered at no cost to the student. However, failure to report for testing session(s) will result in the parent reimbursing Aledo ISD for the cost of the exam(s).

Grades 1-5: Students in grades 1-5 may be accelerated one grade level upon successful completion (80% or above) on **each** of the following exams: Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies.

Grades 6-12: Students in grades 6-12 may earn credit for an academic course upon successful completion (80% or above) of the exam or exams (students must pass **both** semesters to earn credit). If a student earns credit in a subject on the basis of an exam, Aledo ISD must enter the exam score on the student's permanent record.

Testing will be conducted in 3-hour sessions, one in the morning and one in the afternoon. Students are limited to one exam per session. CBE's administered at the campus level may vary the start/ending time as long as the 3-hour time frame is maintained.
